2012 HOW TO REGISTER

Rainbow Trail now offers on-line registration for youth camps, Family Camps, and Labor Day.

- Youth camp registrations will now be accepted on a first come, first served basis through the mail and online starting November 1st.
- The first official registration date for Family Camp and Labor Day BEGINS December 1st for either paper or on-line registrations. On-line and paper registrations received prior to this date will receive a postmark of December 1st. PAPER REGISTRATIONS ARE PROCESSED BY POSTMARK DATE (not date received) until December 8th, 2011. On-line registrations will be processed by date stamp on each on-line record. Family Camp and Labor Day registrations will be pulled in a lottery fashion. This is for Family Camp and Labor Day only.
- REGISTER EARLY! Weeks fill up quickly. Send separate registration forms for each camper. Please include a second choice.
- A deposit of \$100.00 for all youth camps MUST accompany the registration form. The week-long family camp deposit is \$300.00 per family or \$150 for single individuals. Labor Day deposits are \$150 per family. Balances are due by May 15, 2012. We honor Visa/Mastercard for both deposits and balance due.
- IMPORTANT:** All youth camp deposits are nonrefundable and nontransferable after April 1, 2012. All family camp deposits are non-refundable after April 1, 2012. A service fee of \$25 will be charged on refunds prior to that date.
- CAMPERSHIPS are available for those in need of financial assistance. Call or email the Canon City office for details. Don't let money be a reason your child does not come to camp.
- Colorado law requires a physical exam be completed within 24 months prior to arrival at camp.
- Before January 1, 2012, registration preference will be given to Lutherans of the Rocky Mountain Synod, ELCA. After that date, open registration will be in effect.
- SPECIAL FAMILY DISCOUNT:** A discount will be given in cases where more than one child of an immediate family will be attending a RTLCL youth camp. The first child will be charged the full rate and each additional sibling will receive a \$20.00 discount. Be sure to check the box at the top of form.
- All cancellations need to be in writing, either by mail or email.
- Rules for acceptance and participation in the program are the same for all, regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or handicap. If you believe you have been discriminated against, write the Sec. of Agriculture, Washington, D.C. 20250.
