FAQ’s

How much does it cost?

Total cost is \$135 for youth and \$95 for adult leaders. A \$35 per person, non-refundable deposit is due upon registration.

How many adults should we bring?

There is a 1:9 ratio of same-gender adult leader to youth required. You will need a same-gender adult leader for each gender of youth in your group.

How do we register?

Every participant (adults included) must fill out the Individual Registration Form online at rainbowtrail.org. If your group leader plans to enter all individuals’ information, we have provided a printable Individual Registration Form online to help leaders collect the information we need.

Please also fill out the online Group Registration Form to inform RTLCL of numbers per group, breakdown of genders, etc.




About the Speaker
