- Don't let money be a reason your child does not come to camp. Colorado law requires a physical exam be completed within 24 months prior to arrival at camp.
- Before January 1, 2025, registration preference will be given to Lutherans of the Rocky Mountain Synod, ELCA. After that date, open registration will be in effect.
- SPECIAL FAMILY DISCOUNT: A discount will be given in cases where more than one child of an immediate family will be attending a RTLC youth camp. The first child will be charged the full rate and each additional sibling will receive a \$20.00 discount.
- All cancellations need to be in writing, either by mail or email.
- Rules for acceptance and participation in the program are the same for all, regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or handicap, if you believe you have been discriminated against, write the Sec. of Agriculture, Washington, D.C. 20250.
- A complete set of registration policies is located on our website.

- Youth, Family Camp, and Labor Day registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis online starting November 1st.
- REGISTER ONLINE EARLY! Weeks fill up quickly.
- A deposit of \$100.00 for all youth camps MUST accompany the registration. The week-long Family Camp deposit is \$300.00 per family or \$150 for single individuals. Labor Day deposits are \$150 per family. Balances are due by May 15, 2025. We honor Visa/Mastercard for both deposits and balance due.
- IMPORTANT: All youth camp deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable after April 1, 2025. All family camp deposits are non-refundable after April 1, 2025. A service fee of \$25 will be charged on refunds prior to that date.
